CONSOLIDATION RULING

In the matter of the Department of Corrections Ruling Number 2017-4574 June 30, 2016

This ruling addresses the consolidation of the grievant's three grievances filed with the Department of Corrections (the agency). For the reasons discussed below, the Office of Employment Dispute Resolution (EDR) finds that consolidation of these grievances into a single hearing is appropriate and practicable.

FACTS

The three grievances at issue are 1) a January 26, 2017 grievance challenging the agency's issuance of a Group II Written Notice dated January 10, 2017, 2) a January 26, 2017 grievance challenging the issuance of a Group I Written Notice dated January 10, 2017, and 3) a January 26, 2017 challenging the issuance of a second Group II Written Notice dated January 10, 2017. During the management resolution steps, the grievances were addressed simultaneously, and the grievant does not object to consolidation.

DISCUSSION

Approval by EDR in the form of a compliance ruling is required before two or more grievances may be consolidated in a single hearing. Moreover, EDR may consolidate grievances for hearing without a request from either party. EDR strongly favors consolidation and will consolidate grievances when they involve the same parties, legal issues, policies, and/or factual background, unless there is a persuasive reason to process the grievances individually.³

EDR finds that consolidation of the three January 26, 2017 grievances is appropriate. These grievances involve the same grievant and could share common themes, claims, and witnesses. Further, we find that consolidation is not impracticable in this instance. Therefore,

the grievant's three January 26, 2017 grievances are consolidated for a single hearing. A hearing officer will be appointed in a forthcoming letter.

EDR's rulings on compliance are final and nonappealable.⁴
