CONSOLIDATION RULING

In the matter of the Virginia Department of Transportation Ruling Numbers 2016-4214, 2016-4215 August 20, 2015

This ruling addresses the consolidation of the grievant's two grievances filed with the Department of Transportation (the agency). For the reasons discussed below, the Office of Employment Dispute Resolution (EDR) finds that consolidation of these grievances into a single hearing is appropriate and practicable.

FACTS

The two grievances at issue are 1) an August 11, 2015 grievance challenging the agency's issuance of a Group III Written Notice dated July 10, 2015, and 2) an August 14, 2015 dismissal grievance challenging the issuance of a Group II Written Notice on July 30, 2015, accompanying the grievant's termination from employment. Both parties agree that consolidation is appropriate in this instance.

DISCUSSION

Approval by EDR in the form of a compliance ruling is required before two or more grievances may be consolidated in a single hearing. Moreover, EDR may consolidate grievances for hearing without a request from either party.¹ EDR strongly favors consolidation and will consolidate grievances when they involve the same parties, legal issues, policies, and/or factual background, unless there is a persuasive reason to process the grievances individually.²

EDR finds that consolidation of the August 11, 2015 and the August 14, 2015 grievances is appropriate. These grievances involve the same grievant and could share common themes, claims, and witnesses. Further, we find that consolidation is not impracticable in this instance. Therefore, the grievant's August 11, 2015 and the August 14, 2015 grievances are consolidated for a single hearing. As agreed by the parties, the August 11, 2014 grievance is qualified in full and will proceed to a hearing in the consolidated matter without going through the management resolution steps. A hearing officer will be appointed in a forthcoming letter.
