## APPEAL REVIEW RULING OF DIRECTOR

In the matter of Virginia Employment Commission Ruling No. 2006-1080 July 15, 2005

Pursuant to Va. Code 2.2-3006(B), the Virginia Employment Commission (agency) seeks approval from the Director of this Department to appeal the final hearing decision in Case No. 8076 on the basis that it is contradictory to law. Because there is no evidence that the agency's appeal is based on any improper purpose such as to harass or cause delay, its request is granted. The agency may now file a notice of appeal with the Circuit Court in the jurisdiction in which the grievance arose. Any such notice must be filed within 30 calendar days of July 15, 2005, the date the hearing decision became final. Approval to proceed with the circuit court appeal in no way reflects the substantive merits of the appeal or addresses the jurisdiction of the circuit court.
