## **COMPLIANCE RULING OF DIRECTOR**

In the matter of the Department of Corrections EDR Ruling No. 2012-3043 August 3, 2011

On July 20, 2011, this Department (EDR) received the grievant's request for a compliance ruling. He alleges that the agency has failed to comply with the provisions of the *Grievance Procedure Manual* concerning documents requested. On July 5, 2011, the grievance at issue was appointed to be heard by a hearing officer.

Once a grievance has been qualified for a hearing, any claims of noncompliance are to be raised with the hearing officer.<sup>1</sup> If a party disagrees with the manner in which the hearing officer addresses the noncompliance, a ruling request can then be submitted to EDR.<sup>2</sup> However, the issue must first be raised with the hearing officer.<sup>3</sup> Addressing this matter with the hearing officer would be of particular importance here as the grievant appears to be seeking a stay during the hearing process.

Because the grievant did not first raise the noncompliance issue with the hearing officer, the grievant's request for a compliance ruling is premature and will not be addressed in this ruling. This Department's rulings on matters of compliance are final and nonappealable.<sup>4</sup>
